1. Parties and Purpose

This Privacy Policy aims to inform users of the website www.azbc.be (“the Site”) about how AZBC collects, uses, and protects personal data.

2. Legal Basis and Processing of Personal Data

Personal data is processed on the following legal bases:

- the User’s consent;
- the performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures;
- AZBC’s legitimate interest.

3. Purposes of Processing

Data is processed to:

- respond to inquiries submitted via the contact form;
- communicate with the User;
- ensure secure and proper functioning of the Site;
- produce anonymized usage statistics.

4. Personal Data Collected

4.1 Data voluntarily provided:

Name, surname, email, phone number, and any information the User voluntarily provides.

4.2 Automatically collected data:

IP address, browser type and version, time zone, operating system, pages visited, session duration.

5. Consent

Use of the Site implies free, informed, and unambiguous acceptance of this Policy.

6. Data Retention

- Contact form data: 12 months.
- Technical navigation data: 6 months.

7. Data Recipients

Internal staff, technical subcontractors, and service providers strictly necessary for service delivery.

8. Transfers Outside the European Union

If data is transferred outside the EU, AZBC ensures adequate safeguards such as:

- adequacy decisions,
- standard contractual clauses,
- or equivalent protective measures.

9. User Rights

Users may exercise the following rights at any time:

access, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, objection, complaint to the supervisory authority.

10. Cookies

The Site may use essential technical cookies. Any non-essential cookie requires explicit consent.

11. Data Security

AZBC implements technical and organizational measures including encryption, restricted access, and secured servers.

12. Protection of Minors

Parental consent is required for users under 16. AZBC does not knowingly process minors' data.

13. Third-Party Links

AZBC is not responsible for external websites or their privacy practices.

14. Changes to the Policy

Changes will be published on the Site.

15. Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

This Policy is governed by Belgian law. Any dispute falls under the jurisdiction of the courts of Nivelles.
